Promoter reserves right to combine categories UCA Points Race. All UCA rules and classes apply.

Route Description:

The 15, 30 & 50 mile race starts at North Summit High School and heads East up Border Station Road until it connects to Chalk Creek Road with a right hand turn then continues East to the corner of Utah & Wyoming for the 50 mile groups.

15 & 30 mile turn arounds are up Chalk Creek road approximately 7.5 miles & 15 miles from the start. The 65 & 80 mile race starts at North Summit High School heading West to Main Street turning left, then heading South to Creamery Ln turning right, then sweeping left turn onto W. Hoytsville Rd. Follow this road until you come to the stop sign in Wanship (corner of W. Hoytsville Rd. and Hoytsville Rd.) where you will make a sharp left turn heading North until you reach Creamery Ln again for your 2nd loop (80 mile race). After your 1 Or 2 loops you will continue on back to the High School by way of Main Street before going up Chalk Creek Road by way of Border Station Road. The Masters A (35+ Cat 1-3) will make 1 loop to Wanship while the Men pro 1/2 & Cat 3 will make 2 loops to Wanship before going up Chalk Creek Road by way of Border Station Road. Riders are responsible for keeping track of the required number of laps. The loops to Wanship will be counter clockwise. The finish is up N. Industrial Park Road past the Cemetery.

*Junior classes race together but are scored separately by age groups: 10-12,13-14,15-16,17-18.

Citizen riders can race Cat 5 men, Cat 4 women, or any junior or masters age class for which they are eligible with a one day license.

One-day licenses are available at registration for \$10

Feed Zone: Coalville City by the North Summit High School (self supported), approximately 100 E. 700 S. after the top of the short hill and at the turn around up Chalk Creek Road (neutral) for Masters A (35+ Cat 1-3) and Men pro 1/2.

Parking & Restrooms: Summit County Fair Grounds, Coalville, Utah. Parking also at the High School.

Directions: From Ogden Utah, take I-84 E to I-80 W toward SLC, follow I-80 to Coalville exit 162.

From Evanston Wyoming, take I-80 toward Salt Lake City to Coalville exit 162. From Salt Lake City Utah, take I-80 East toward Evanston to Coalville exit 162.

All, after taking exit 162 head east to main street. Turn left onto Main St. and then turn right onto Center St. which becomes Park RD. This will take you to the Fair Grounds (202 EAST PARK ROAD, Coalville, UT).

Please park at Fairgrounds or School. **PLEASE DO NOT TRESPASS ON THE BASEBALL FIELD.**

Note: The route link for loops to Wanship show the course going over on Hobson Ln. however the route will be going over on Creamery Ln.
